During February, work progressed on schedule on preparations to present the course "Remote Sensing for Mineral Specialists" beginning March 24, 1980. Instructors for the course have spent their designated time preparing lectures and laboratory exercises, and assembling and creating the visual aids needed. Approximately 90% of the needed imagery is now in-house.

As of the end of February, all arrangements for the use of facilities at BLM have been concluded, including a room for training and audio-visual equipment. Video-taping arrangements are yet to be resolved.

During February, also, arrangements were completed for hiring Donna K. Scholz on the project as a consultant. The necessary contractual paper work has now been completed on those arrangements.
